

There have been a number of break ins to garden sheds in the Boningale area and gardening tools and equipment have been taken. Please be vigilant and take more care when locking up your sheds over the summer months.

Telephone Box in Church Lane, Boningale

The Grade II listed red K6 telephone box in Church Lane, Boningale is in a dilapidated condition and since the advent of mobile phones is no longer used. The Parish Council now have permission from BT and Shropshire Council to adopt the telephone box for £1 but we need your help.
